- Rules:** The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing, as modified by Appendix E, modified AMYA HMS 2016 and the Class Rules of the EC12 Class. Measurement Certificates Required. Sailing Instructions available on [www.EC12.org](http://www.EC12.org).
- Eligibility:** The regatta is open to all boats of the EC-12 Class who are current members of AMYA and who are properly registered with the EC-12 Class.
- Schedule:** Check-in and Practice Sailing 12:00-16:00 Wednesday November 10, 2021.  
Skippers meetings held 9:15 AM each racing day. Friday and Saturday races begin at 9:30 AM, No races will start after 16:00 hrs. Saturday's final race will finish approximately 16:00 hrs.  
Award banquet cocktail Dinner (if held) and prize giving starts at 18:30.
- Location:** Ashland Pond, The Villages, Florida. Detailed directions on TVMYS website.
- Entry:** Eligible boats may be entered by completing an online Entry Form by October 15, 2021, with an entry fee of \$135 which includes lunches and Banquet Dinner. Guest lunch fee \$24 and dinner fee \$40. Entries open August 14 (3 months prior).
- Scoring:** Racing will be held using HMS 2016 V1, Promotion / Relegation using the Low Point Scoring system method of RRS Appendix A. To start the Regatta, skippers will be placed into seeding Fleets based upon the current National Seeding List (NSL). Race scoring and discards will be according to EC12 Florida Association rules.
- Prizes:** Prizes will be awarded to the top six competitors.

These conditions apply throughout the Regatta while at the Pond, Parking Lot and surrounding areas. Upon a second request to comply may result in expulsion from the Regatta at the discretion of the Race Committee.

Social Distancing is required and 6-foot distancing is recommended according to CDC recommendations.

Food and Refreshments: Lunch will be provided each of the three days of the Regatta as well as soft drinks and water. Please arrange to bring your own breakfast, and any special diet items you may require.

Saturday Dinner: There will be a Banquet and Prize Giving Dinner arranged if current condition allow, if not the prize-giving will take place as soon as possible after the last race at the Lake or at a Local Recreation Centre.

Sanitizing Station: will be set up at the Pond so please take advantage of it.

Racing: fleets will be according to HMS but competitors should comply with social distancing requirements especially at the Start. Keep at least 6 feet from the finishing staff. Please do not crowd around the scoreboard keepers. Scores will be displayed.

Race Director: will be responsible to oversee these rules and ensure that they are complied with. Any breach will be referred to the Regatta Committee to take the appropriate action.
